- Prepares requests for concrete plant relocation, environmental, zoning and other permits as required by state laws

- Manages all worker's compensation claims
- Coordinates Occupational Health Services for project sites (physicals, worker's compensation claims, etc.)
- Works with VP of Finance to secure competitive insurance rates and provide overall risk management.
